The [Social Work Census](#) is now live! The Census, an online survey supported by the Social Work Workforce Coalition, will build the most inclusive picture to date of who today's social workers are and what we are doing in our practice.

The Census is an online survey that intends to gather information about social workers, *by* social workers, to be shared *with* social workers. The Census is composed of two parts: a robust workforce study of the social work profession and an analysis of social work practice to be used in developing competence assessments for social work licensing.

The North Carolina Social Work Certification and Licensure Board endorses the new Social Work Census, and we're calling on all social workers and social service workers to make their voice count!

We encourage you to visit SWCensus.org to participate in the Census. The online survey will remain open until May 31, 2024.

Continuing education credits
